- Existing auditors who need refresher training on MD-QMS ISO 13485:2016 or who need to update to the MD edition.

This course contributes to the development of personnel wishing to join the CQI or those wishing to register as an Auditor with the IRCA (International Register of Certified Auditors).

What will delegates learn on this course?

- Quality management systems, principles and terminology, as applied to Medical Devices
- Interpreting the structure and requirements of MD-QMS ISO 13485:2016
- The Process Approach
- Core business processes for Medical Device manufacturing
- Regulatory compliance
- Medical device risk management

ISO 13485 requires personnel to be competent – this course provides knowledge to enable personnel to have an understanding of the Standard while performing their job role.

What is the format of this course?

Combining engaging activities and tutor-led sessions, the course is 25% theory and 75% practical.

What is the course assessment?

- During the ISO 13485 foundation training, participants will be assessed on their general engagement with the course and involvement in the interactive activities.
- Delegates are required to have 100% course attendance (in accordance with CQI and IRCA rules).
